

## SPECIAL CUSTOMS AND PORT REGIME FOR THE PROVINCE OF CABINDA

Goods imported in the Province of Cabinda under the provisions of the Special Customs and Port Regime are for consumption and use in the Province of Cabinda only (Law Decree 4/04 of 21 September and Law Decree 6/06 of 20 December).

In the event that commercial goods imported under the provisions of the Special Customs and Port Regime for Cabinda are removed from this Province, their owners must declare them to the Customs Post at Cabinda Airport, **prior** to checking in with the airline at the Airport or to any other Customs Delegation before removing them from the Province by any other means of transport.

All documents that provide evidence of the goods having been imported in Cabinda must be attached to the Declaration for the payment of the additional Customs levies and duties in accordance with the provisions of the Customs General Regime (the Customs regime applicable in the rest of Angola). These documents include, respectively, a copy of the Customs Declaration Form (Documento Unico) duly stamped by Customs at the time of importation under the Special Customs and Port Regime for Cabinda; a copy of the Customs Clearance Note (Nota de Desalfandegamento) and the original of the receipt of payment of Customs duties and levies (DAR).

The owners of the goods should keep all the documentation that proves payment of all additional Customs duties and levies.

Passengers should arrive at the Airport in Cabinda well in advance of their check-in time to ensure they comply with this requirement and to avoid potential constraints and unnecessary delays.

False declarations are subject to fines in accordance with the law.

REASONABLY BE REQUIRED FOR PERSONAL USE DURING THEIR

THEIR EXCLUSIVE PROFESSIONAL USE**

## **RED CHANNEL**

**YOU MUST ENTER THE RED CHANNEL WHEN:**

**YOU ARE CARRYING PROHIBITED OR RESTRICTED GOODS SUCH AS  
ILLICIT DRUGS, HAND GUNS, FIREARMS, DIAMONDS, ETC**

**YOU HAVE GOODS IN EXCESS OF YOUR DUTY FREE ALLOWANCE**

**YOU HAVE COMMERCIAL GOODS**

**YOU ARE CARRYING CURRENCY IN EXCESS OF USD 15,000 OR AN  
EQUIVALENT AMOUNT IN ANY OTHER CURRENCY;**

**YOU ARE ARRIVING AIR CREW HAVING BEEN ON DUTY ON THE AR-  
RIVING FLIGHT**

**WHEN YOU ARE IN DOUBT AS TO WHAT TO DECLARE**

**PENALTIES FOR FALSE DECLARATIONS ARE SEVERE**

**UNDECLARED PROHIBITED, RESTRICTED OR COMMERCIAL GOODS  
WILL BE SEIZED**
